Services

Water

Potable water is available at all wharves. Contact the wharf owner to make arrangements. For the Railway wharf, contact Town of Lunenburg Public Works at 902-634-8992.

Electrical

Electrical service is limited and generally available only at private wharves.

Telephone

A landline can be installed with prior notice to MTT (local phone service provider)
Numerous payphones are available around town, the closest to the main waterfront being:

1. At foot of stairs to Duke Street (outside Grand Banker/Dockside Restaurants)
2. Outside Adams & Knickle's offices on Montague Street
3. Outside Post Office on King Street

Internet

Pump Out

Sewage pump out services are available. Advise harbour master of your requirements at least one business day prior to requiring service. Service is dependent upon acceptance of waste by the waste disposal site. Permission will be obtained by the harbour master prior to pump out. Oily water pump out is also available, contact the harbour master.

Garbage

Advise harbour master of your requirements at least one business day prior to requiring service. Recycleable plastics and metals must be in blue or clear bags. Domestic landfill must be double bagged. Charges are as per the contractor's hourly rate and will depend on quantity and what arrangements have to be made at the recycling depot. International garbage must be handled as per CFIA requirements. This is costly in Lunenburg and should be left for the ship's next call at a major port. If this is not practical, contact the harbour master.

Pilotage

Pilotage is non-compulsory. Arrangements may be made by the harbour master. Alternatively, contact the Atlantic Pilotage Authority at 877-272-3477 or Inmarsat 902-426-7610. All pilotage service requires 24hr notice.

In the case of all services for which a fee is charged, these fees are to be paid by the ship's agent directly to the contractors providing the service. Such fees are negotiated solely by the agent and the contractor. The harbour master has no interest in such negotiations. The harbour master cannot process invoices on behalf of any ship.
