

Town of Lunenburg
2019/20 Application for Residential Property Tax Relief

A partial residential property tax reduction for the 2019/20 taxation year is available to residential property taxpayers whose total household income is less than \$21,000. and the property is occupied by the applicant taxpayer as his/her principal residence. The amount of the exemption is based on the following income scale to provide greater assistance to lower income families:

<u>Income</u>	<u>Exemption</u>
\$18,000. or less	\$500.
\$18,001. to \$19,000.	\$400.
\$19,001. to \$20,000.	\$300.
\$20,001. to \$21,000.	\$200.
over \$21,000.	No Exemption

Please note:

- Your completed application form must be received by **June 28, 2019**. **Late applications will not be considered.**
- The affidavit on page 2 of this form must be signed in the presence of a Commissioner of Oaths who are available to assist you at the Town Hall.
- Your application will be considered to determine whether you qualify for Residential Property Tax relief. ***You will be notified of the results of your application and if you qualify, a credit will appear on your final tax bill issued September 1.***
