The Lunenburg waterfront is a gateway to delicious culinary experiences in award-winning restaurants, galleries, locally inspired experiences and shops, and events celebrating diverse talents and traditions.

Dine on a patio, uncover seaside treasures and watch local boatbuilders at work, all along the beautiful Lunenburg waterfront. Catch the sunset with the best view dockside.

Stroll the streets lined with charming 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> century architecture and experience the authenticity of this UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit the ships that call Lunenburg home: three-masted barque *Picton Castle*, and iconic *Bluenose II*, Nova Scotia's sailing ambassador (bluenose.novascotia.ca).

Take in the numerous sights and sounds on this working waterfront, from wooden schooners being built at the Dory Shop, and vessels under repair to fresh seafood catches unloaded at the wharves.

### DINGHY DOCK

- Designated dinghy dock
- Overnight registration required

#### Please Note:

- **Smoking is not allowed on the wharves or museum property.** It is very important that boaters understand that the wooden wharves represent a fire hazard.
- Availability of berths is subject to change seasonally or if being used for maintenance, special events or other operational considerations.



### ZWICKER WHARF

Public docking for tenders & dinghies

- Public access to and from the waterfront is available near this wharf
- Designated dinghy dock area
- Daily and overnight dockage on 300 ft. (91.4 m) of floating dock
- Power and Potable Water
- Garbage receptacles (sorted garbage only)

### SHIPYARD WHARF

Marina services for visiting commercial boaters

- Berthing for boats up to 45 ft. (13.7 m) is available at the floats; larger vessels can berth at the wharves. Berthing with reservation only, call 902-521-3012

- Garbage receptacles (sorted garbage only)
- Winter storage
